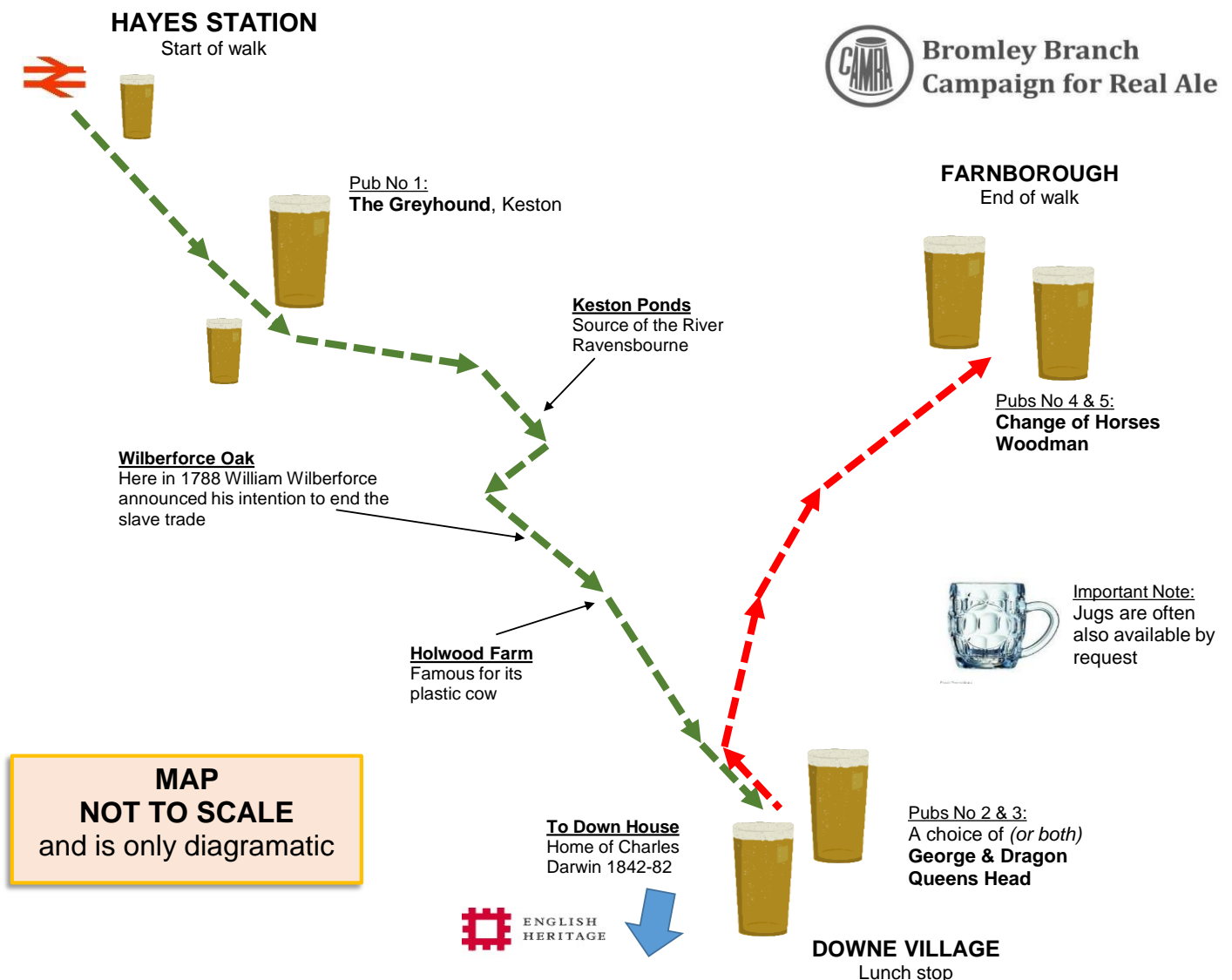


# The 4th Annual Bromley Cramble

Saturday 22 April 2017

Once again Bromley CAMRA and Bromley Ramblers have joined forces to arrange a walk through some of the rural parts of Bromley borough. The walk starts at Hayes Station and the route will take us via Hayes and Keston Commons, through the attractive village of Downe to finish at Farnborough.

Distance: Approx 7 miles  
 Start time: 10:30 prompt  
 Lunch stop: Approx 12:45 to 14:15 in Downe village. Option to join or leave walk at this point  
 Finish Time: Approx arrival time at Farnborough 15:30  
 Terrain: Mostly off-road paths, likely to be muddy in places, boots are recommended

Buses 119 from Bromley or Croydon  
353 from Orpington or Croydon  
Plus other buses from Bromley

### Downe

Buses 146 from Bromley  
R8 from Orpington

### Farnborough

Buses 358 to Orpington or Bromley/Crystal Palace  
Arriva 402 (non-TFL) to Bromley or Sevenoaks

As always, the actual beers available on the day may change, but in early February 2017 the following beers were available:

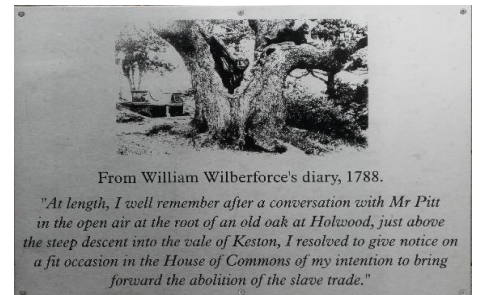
