

BROMLEY CAMRA, BRANCH AREA REPRESENTATIVE ROLE DESCRIPTION.

Purpose of the role:

To be a representative for the members of CAMRA and pubs within their designated area of the Branch.

Activities in their area may include any or all of the following.

- To act as liaison between members, pubs and the Branch.
- To promote links between CAMRA and publicans.
- To keep pubs informed of the help and support available to them from CAMRA.
- To encourage pubs to take part in CAMRA's campaigns and initiatives.
- To distribute *London Drinker*.
- To encourage pubs to display CAMRA leaflets and other CAMRA material and keep them topped-up.
- To write any *Good Beer Guide* entries required.
- To check the accuracy of *Whatpub*.
- To submit beer scores and encourage others to do the same.
- To attend Branch Committee Meetings and take part in discussions and decisions.
- To assist other branch committee members if requested.
- To be the eyes and ears on the ground and to feedback any developments, good or bad, to the branch.

General

This role has no set timeframe; it can take as much or little time as the Representative can give. There are no special skills necessary. Advice and guidance on CAMRA policy is available from other branch committee members and CAMRA's Head Office.
