

# Beer Scores (NBSS) Co-ordinator

## Role summary

## Important function

### Are you interested in helping to locate and compare great quality beers?

As Beer Scores Co-ordinator you would encourage branch members to submit beer scores via the National Beer Scoring System (NBSS) for pubs and clubs within your branch area, analyse them and present information to the branch for deciding annual nominations for the *Good Beer Guide* and for other purposes.

#### The role involves

- Downloading scores from NBSS and presenting them to help the branch make nominations for the *Good Beer Guide*, Pub of the Year, Club of the Year, etc.
- Promoting beer scoring to members at branch meetings, in branch newsletters or magazines and via the branch website.
- If used by the branch, presenting scores for a branch members' beer scores competition for pubs and clubs within the branch area.

#### Useful skills and knowledge

- Access to a computer/tablet and the internet.
- Working knowledge of MS Excel.
- Good interpersonal and writing skills.

#### Time commitment

- This role can take up as much time as you are prepared to give. An hour a month is probably typical except at key times such as downloading from NBSS for *Good Beer Guide* selection meetings, periodic beer scores competitions, etc.
- Regular attendance at local branch meetings is useful.
