

Could you be the person to enthuse branch members to participate in branch activities?

As the **Chair** you'd lead the branch, helping to set its direction and encourage local CAMRA members to get involved and enjoy branch activities.

The role involves

- Providing leadership for the branch and helping to motivate its members.
- Promoting campaigning for quality beer, pubs and clubs as a central part of branch activities.
- Promoting interesting and effective communications to branch members and to external bodies.
- Taking part in regional discussions and with neighbouring branches (may be delegated).
- Overseeing effective running of the branch and its finances.
- Arranging democratic, transparent and timely selection processes for the [Good Beer Guide](#), [Pub of the Year](#) and other awards.

Useful skills and knowledge

- Good interpersonal, written and communication skills.
- Ability to lead meetings towards clear, consensus decisions.
- Access to the internet and a computer/tablet.

Time commitment

- Hours are flexible to suit you but would usually be one or two hours a week except at key times, for example during the local beer festival.
- Ideally you'd represent your branch at Regional CAMRA meetings which would help you with the role. This could be delegated if it's not always possible to take part.
