Role summary

Essential function

Would you like to take charge of your branch's selection and submission of pubs and clubs for inclusion in the Good Beer Guide?

CAMRA's Good Beer Guide (GBG) is the definitive publication for finding the very best beers. Every branch needs somebody to organise the selection process and you could be the person to make this happen for your branch.

The role involves

- Identifying the top pubs and clubs with the best beer quality.
- Organising surveys of potential candidates for the Guide.
- Organising a fair selection process involving members.
- Updating the information for each pub or club to go into the Guide.
- Submitting the branch nominations before the deadline in early March.
- Proof-reading the entries.

Useful skills and knowledge

- Attention to detail and to deadlines.
- Good ability in written English.
- Familiarity with online web forms.

Time commitment

- The role is seasonal. The selection processes typically runs from November until February, with electronic submissions in early March. In the run-up to the deadline a week's worth of evenings may be required.
- Regular attendance at branch meetings over the winter period is very useful.
