
# Bromley Pub Walk No. 2

### Keston to Leaves Green

### Via Nash

An almost entirely rural walk through farmland and horse pastures in the valley below Keston





Approx. Distance:	3.5 miles
Approx. Time:	<b>1.5</b> hours
Gradients:	Steep ascent up Fox Lane from Nash up to Keston, also an ascent up the path through fields from the bridleway up to Leaves Green
Type(s) of path(s):	Bridleway, tracks, paths
Stiles / Gates:	Several stiles and kissing gates.
Road Walking: (ie. roads without footway)	Fox Lane (approx. 600 yds.), Nash Lane (approx. 100 yds.) and Blackness Lane / Jackass Lane (approx. 400 yds.)
Livestock or crops:	Some fields have livestock or crops, also riding schools and horse pastures

## Bromley Pub Walk No. 2

	From Leaves Green:  3 to Leaves Green via Wilberforce Oak  6 to Downe  7 to Farnborough  61 to Tatsfield  62 to Fickleshole  This route follows the same paths as parts of routes 62 and 63
Pubs / Clubs:	Keston  Fox Inn, Heathfield Road, Keston. BR2 6BQ  Greyhound, Commonside, Keston. BR2 6BP  Leaves Green  Kings Arms, Leaves Green Rd. BR2 6DU
Public Transport:	Keston  146 Bromley North/South to Downe  246 Bromley North/South to Westerham  Leaves Green  320 Catford to Biggin Hill via Bromley South  246 Bromley North/South to Westerham  R2 Orpington to Biggin Hill
Notes:	The bridleway can be very muddy at some times of year. For part of the route there is a path (not a right of way) to the east of the bridleway which is used by many walkers. This route is not only much less muddy, but it also affords a better view of the surrounding area than is possible from the hedge-lined bridleway.

#### The Route:

#### (Starting at Keston)

- Walk down Fox Lane (next to the Fox pub) to junction with Jackass Lane, then take footpath to Nash
- Path briefly joins Nash Lane then take path adjacent to riding stable (following Bromley Council's Nash Circular route) to Jackass Lane
- Follow Jackass Lane to Blackness Lane and then take the bridleway (following Bromley Council's Leaves Green Circular route) and then across field up to Leaves Green

#### (Starting at Leaves Green)


The route starts in the track off the A233 opposite the Kings Arms
