Committee Elections

So far we have received nominations for Chair, Secretary, Branch Contact, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, Social Secretary, Pubs Database Coordinator, Beer Scores Coordinator, LocAle Coordinator, Women's Representative, Web Master, Pub Protection Officer, and Area Representatives for BR2, BR3, BR4, BR5, BR6, SE20 and Biggin Hill & Cudham.

We would particularly like to encourage nominations for the following posts for which we have not received nominations at the time of writing: Public Affairs Officer, Festival Organiser, Newsletter Editor, Cider Representative, Pubs Protection Officer, Under 30s Representative, and Area Representatives for BR7 (Chislehurst area) and BR1 (Central Bromley), the latter currently being a shared role.

If you would like to apply for a vacancy

Working as a member of the committee is normally a fulfilling and enjoyable role with the opportunity to meet other people with a common interest.

You will need to fill in a form (below) for the vacancy concerned which will also need to be countersigned by two other current members of Bromley CAMRA. If no-one else applies for the position, it is probable that you will be elected unopposed at the AGM. If there are 2 or more applicants for a position, the matter will be put to a vote.
