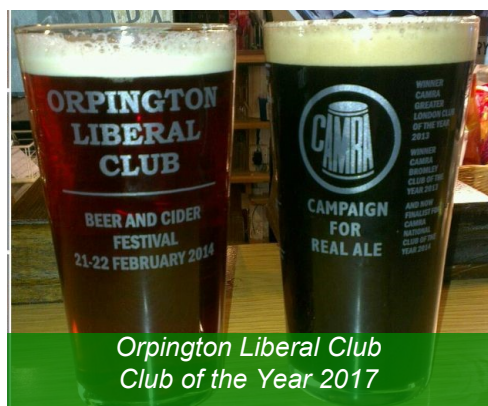
All members are invited to the presentations of the winners' awards, both of which will take place at their forthcoming beer festivals:
