0	NO CASK ALE.	0.5 = UNDRINKABLE. Or so poor you have to take it back or can't finish it
1	POOR. Beer that is anything from barely drinkable to drinkable with considerable resentment	
2	AVERAGE. Competently kept, drinkable pint but doesn't inspire in any way, not worth moving on to the next pub but you drink the beer without noticing	
3	GOOD. Good beer in good form. You may cancel plans to move to the next pub. You may want to stay for another pint and may seek out the beer again	
4	VERY GOOD. Excellent beer in excellent condition	
5	PERFECT. Probably the best that you are ever likely to find. A seasoned drinker will award this score very rarely
