Winners announced for the 2019 Bromley CAMRA Pub and Club of the Year Awards

Pub of the Year

Bromley CAMRA is pleased to announce that the <u>Star & Garter</u> has been awarded the title of Bromley Branch pub of the Year for 2019. This is the second consecutive year that this pub has won the award.

After being closed for a number of years the pub reopened under new management in November 2016 and now regularly offers a range of cask beers, many of which were previously rarely seen in Bromley, including beers from Arbor, Kirkstall, Marble, Siren and Wylam, all currently being sold at only £3 a pint. With up to 7 beers on handpump, the selection normally includes at least one stout and/or a porter. Draft cider, plus up to 16 craft keg and imported draft beers are also available.

The 2019 award will be presented to the pub on **Tuesday 4th June**, more details will be published nearer the time.

This year we have awarded runner-up title jointly to the Red Lion in Bromley North and the Real Ale Way in Hayes.

The <u>Red Lion</u>, a traditional pub in the quiet backstreets behind Bromley North station, has been serving consistently good beer to regular customers and discerning visitors for many years and has deservedly been listed in the Good Beer Guide every year since 1998.

The <u>Real Ale Way</u>, Bromley's third micropub, only opened in July 2018 in former shop premises opposite Hayes Station. Up to nine real ales are served, dispensed by gravity from a cold room at the rear of the bar, the range now often includes a porter or stout. Ales are normally from Kent breweries, with occasional guest beers providing variety.

Club of the Year

We are also pleased to announce that <u>Orpington Liberal Club</u> has been awarded the title of Bromley Branch Club of the Year for 2019.

The club has now won the Bromley title every year since 2013, it has also won the Greater London CAMRA Regional award in 2013, 2015, 2017 and 2018 and was a CAMRA National Club of the Year Finalist in 2014 and 2016. It has also been listed in the Good Beer Guide every year since 2013.

As most members will already be aware, the club serves a regularly-changing selection of beers, mostly from small breweries, the large quantity of pump clips adorning the walls shows the large quantity of beers served over the past few years. Usually 3 or 4 beers are available, often including a stout or porter, together with a selection of real ciders. CAMRA members are welcome as visitors to the club on production of a current CAMRA membership card.

The 2019 award will be presented to the club on **Monday 8th April**, more details will be published nearer the time.
